Discussion

For a very long time, the role of mother and father in child development has been a topic for discussion in the social science research. The researchers have also focused on the negative impact of living with the homosexual parents, discussing how the social, emotional and psychological health of the children is effected when they are deprived of the casual and a typical mother-father relationship. ----- quoted six studies to prove that the children of the homosexual parents are more likely to have problems with the social relationships. A study of 36 adults raised by homosexual parents show that they face challenges relating to their ability to trust people, while another study of 68 women with homosexual parents proved that they were less comfortable with intimacy and closeness, they are less able to depend on others and they tend to experience more anxiety in their relationships when compared to the women who are raised by the typical parents. In another study, the socio-emotional development of children was analyzed. It is found that there is limited scope of same sex parenting but the quality of social development depends on the type of resources provided and the quality of life that homosexual parents ensure for their children. However, it is a general assumption that children of homosexual parents are more fearful of their sexual orientation and because of the specific identity associated with them.



They are more likely to have problems with social relationships in terms of making friends, or introducing friends to the families or taking up representative positions. Although homosexual parents ensure that their identity don't affect their children still, children have a sense of insecurity that challenges their confidence and it is one of the reasons that the children are not academically excellent, rather there is a less ratio of the children graduating or looking for white collar jobs. Sometimes, this inability to have better social relationship is also transferred by parents who are less conscious about the well-being of their children because of their sexual insecurity and it ultimately affects the children. Investigating the sexual identity of children of homosexual parents, data from the National Longitudinal Lesbian Family Study (NLLFS) was retrieved and it is inferred that the children of the homosexual parents are not likely to identify heterosexual relationships or need, rather, they are more attracted to the same genders and it is also confirmed by the William Institute at the UCLA School of Law, a think tank that focuses on studying gender and sexual orientation.

Then, as the children are raised by the no judgmental parents, so the children are more attuned to their own feelings that are developed because of homosexual environment. However, it is also argued that the children of the homosexual parents are more likely to have freedom regarding their sex orientation but there are also hurdled by lack of understanding. According to the data collected from the US Department of Health and Human Services, Administration on Children, Youth and Families, it is found that approximately 1.2% children are maltreated every year. There are different factors that can contribute to the risk of maltreatment, such as disability of the parents, familial issues, poverty and one of the most significant factor is, the different gender identity of the parents, or belonging to LGBT community.
